An annual scholarship of \$2000 will be awarded to an individual to honour Captain Kevin Hagen's legacy in the Canadian Armed Forces and at 848 Royal Roads Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron (RCACS).

Applications Due March 31.

Application Criteria & Instructions

Captain Kevin Hagen was an RCAF Pilot and had a passion for flying and aviation. He joined 848 Royal Roads RCACS at the age of 13 with his sights set on achieving his goal of becoming a pilot in the Air Force. Captain Kevin Hagen's family, and the RMC Class of 2011, have generously donated all funds to 848 Royal Roads RCACS for a scholarship to be awarded annually in memory of this exceptional individual.

This scholarship is to be awarded to a current Air Cadet who has a strong passion in the Aviation Industry and will be pursuing further education to help bring that vision to life. This cadet has shown commitment to the aviation program and can carry on Kevin's legacy in the future by furthering their aviation career.

This individual must also demonstrate the following requirements:

- Must be 16 years of age at the time of application
- Must have 90-100% attendance at 848 Royal Roads RCACS
- Must have 90-100% attendance in ground school
- Must have a strong passion for aviation that continues after their age-out
- Good record of community involvement

The application must be supported by the following documentation:

1. A letter from the applicant (min. 500 words), describing their interest in and their future goals for pursuing aviation and how they would carry on Kevin Hagen's legacy
2. A one-page summary of applicant's cadet career, extra-curricular school activities, and community activities (point-form is sufficient)
3. At least one letter of recommendation from a person outside of the cadet program (not a friend or relative)
4. A copy of the most recently available transcript of secondary school marks

This individual must also receive strong recommendations from the Commanding Officer and the Ground School Instructor(s).

The value of this scholarship will be \$2000 annually. Applications will be reviewed by the adult staff at 848 Royal Roads RCACS. The successful applicant will be announced at the Annual Ceremonial Review of the year of application. Completed applications must be received no later than March 31.
